## **Beginning Inlay with Jeff Fulkerson**

### **About the Artist**

Artist Jeff Fulkerson has been creating stunning, imaginative jewelry for over 30 years. He has taught at the Bead & Button Show, Bead Fest, Art Unraveled, the San Diego Museum of Man, and private studios. A contributing artist to Lapidary Journal/Jewelry Artist Magazine, his work has also been seen in Art Jewelry Magazine, Rock & Gem Magazine and Step by Step Wire. Jeff has also produced instructional videos on “Beginning Inlaying Jewelry”, “Stone on Stone”, “Making Concho Belts With the Hydraulic Press” and “Rings!” as well as up-coming articles in Lapidary Journal and Step by Step Wire. A self-taught silver-smith with a background in construction and design, he counts himself fortunate to have studied with many great Native American artists.

### **Workshop Description:**

Students will create a project in sterling silver, learning how to inlay stones into metal, create intarsias, drill stones, and cut, grind and polish stones. Students should be comfortable with soldering and silver fabrication, so as to maximize time spent on inlay techniques.
